4/19/2021 - Minutes

### Call To Order

Chair Andahl called the meeting to order at 5:25 PM.

### HRC Mission

The mission was read by Chair Andahl.

#### 1. Approval Of Meeting Minutes

Chair Andahl called for consideration of the minutes of the March 22, 2021 special meeting.

Motion: Krista Rausch made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2021 special meeting as presented. Sargianna Wutzke seconded the motion, and it was unanimously approved with committee members in attendance voting in favor of the motion.
