ITEM: Consider request to approve applications for the Burleigh County American Rescue Plan funding

REQUEST:

Consider approval of applications for grant funding from the Burleigh County American Rescue Plan proceeds for the new Public Health Facility and for water and sewer infrastructure for the Water and Wastewater Treatment Plants.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law and established fiscal recovery funds for metropolitan cities, non-entitlement units of local government, and counties to make necessary investments in public health, water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure. Burleigh County has grant funding available under the ARPA for necessary investments in public health, water and sewer infrastructure. Public Health along with the Water Treatment Plant and the Wastewater Treatment Plant have necessary infrastructure needs, to maintain their levels of service to protect public health, that are suitable for ARPA funding.

RECOMMENDED CITY COMMISSION ACTION:

Approve request to apply for the Burleigh County American Rescue Plan funding for public health, water and wastewater infrastructure.
