**REQUEST:**

Consider Approval of Resolution of Necessity for SI 561.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Street Improvement District No. 561 consists of one unit of asphalt resurfacing and reconstruction of existing roadways. Resurfacing would include patching, leveling, milling, overlay, chip seal, and related items; reconstruction would include full depth pavement removal and replacement, subgrade modification, stormwater and ground water improvements and related items. Unit 1 consists of 1,850 LF of resurfaced roadway improvements and 3,040 LF of reconstructed roadway improvements.

Letters will be sent to property owners notifying them of this project along with their estimated special assessment cost and their right to protest this improvement per NDCC Chapter 40-22. The Engineering Report along with the district boundary maps has been posted to the city website under Special Assessment District Information at [www.bismarcknd.gov/streets](http://www.bismarcknd.gov/streets).
