ITEM: Request approval to use Prairie Dog grant funding on three water projects

REQUEST:

Approval to use Prairie Dog grant funds on capital improvement projects under PWU 22-10 and PWU 22-11.

Please place this item on the April 26, 2022, City Commission meeting consent agenda.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City has \$2.5 million available in Prairie Dog grant funding for critical infrastructure projects.

Three construction contracts and their associated engineering construction administration contracts will be underway this construction season. Two have been bid with construction starting soon and the third will be bid in the near future. These three water projects are approved 2022 Capital Improvement Projects under PWU 22-10 and PWU 22-11.

The projects include rehabilitation of the 43rd Avenue water tower; High Lift 5 pump replacement at the water treatment plant; and the Filters 1-6 face piping rehabilitation with 12 MGD Accelerator Effluent Pipe Improvements Project at the water treatment plant.

RECOMMENDED CITY COMMISSION ACTION:

Approve \$2.5 million in Prairie Dog grant funding for use on three projects under 2022 CIP PWU 22-10 and PWU 22-11.

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
