ITEM: Request Approval to Apply for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Funding

REQUEST:

Bismarck-Burleigh Public Health is requesting permission to apply for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funding from the ND Department of Emergency Services for costs associated with an emergency power generator for the new Bismarck-Burleigh Public Health facility.

Please place this item on the May 24, 2022, City Commission meeting agenda.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

As a critical facility, a generator is needed to ensure power during emergency and/or disaster situations and power outages at the new public health facility. This ensures life safety and public health's ability to respond to emergency disaster situations. The public health department manages critical vaccines which are refrigerated and/or frozen need to be kept at proper temperature at all times. The ND Department of Emergency Services is accepting projects for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program and the costs and supplies associated with the generator and installation is an applicable project. There is a local match requirement for this project of 15% which could be provided as cash or in-kind/contributions. The estimated total budget for this project is \$176,510 with the local match requirement of \$26,477 (15%).

RECOMMENDED CITY COMMISSION ACTION:

Recommend approval to apply for Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funding from the ND Department of Emergency Services.
