A special pet license may be revoked for the following reasons:

1. Dog(s) and/or cat(s) kept at the premises are habitually at large.
2. Offspring from the breeding of dogs and/or cats kept at the premises are habitually at large.
3. Noise or odors from premises are offensive or a nuisance.
4. Unsanitary or unhealthy conditions exist at the premises.
5. The dog(s) and/or cat(s) kept at the premises are unlicensed.
6. There are more than three unaltered dogs and/or cats at the premises.
7. The applicant has failed to redeem an impounded dog or cat kept under the special license.
8. The applicant has committed cruelty to animals as defined by Section 3-01-04 of Bismarck's Code of Ordinances.

The following items must be submitted with this application:

- \$75.00 fee – Checks payable to Bismarck-Burleigh Public Health
- Vaccination and spay/neuter records for all cats and dogs that includes the age, weight and breed of the animals.
